



**Here is a turn by turn description of the 2018 Reno 10 Miler & Relay course.**

The opening stretch is straight down Foster Drive. Left on Booth in the southbound lane.

The next part of the course is only for the Reno 10 Miler & Relay. Turn right and run east on Riverside. Then left on Ralston and north in the bike lane on the east side of Ralston. Then right on University Terrace running eastbound using the westbound lane. This will be a two way runner section, stay on the right. Continue east on 9th Street. This also will be a two way runner section so be on the right side. Then you will turn left on Center and enter the UNR campus, completing about a mile loop before exiting at this same location. Please note that there are some narrow runner lanes and sharp turns on the UNR campus, so be careful and cautious. Also due to a recently undertaken major construction project on the south end of the Quad, we will have to run a short bit on the grass. Once back to 9th, you will turn right and run due west on that street and University Terrace to Ralston, staying on the right in the two way runner section. Then left on Ralston running south down the hill in the bike lane on the east side of the street. Then right on Riverside, left on Booth, and a quick right on Idlewild.

From here, you will finish on the Journal Jog course. Right on Idlewild in the westbound lane. Right on Cowan which will become Latimore. There is a short out and back on Spoon; be sure to stay on the left. After leaving Idlewild Park, you will continue west on Idlewild in the westbound lane all the way to Chrissie Caughlin Park. Left on Riverberry in the northbound lane. Left on River Run in the northbound lane. Left on Mayberry in the westbound bike lane. Left on Sherwood in the northbound lane. Left on Balsam in the westbound lane, then a quick right on Sherwood in the northbound lane. Right on California staying in the eastbound lane. Left on Robin in the northbound lane. Right on Foster in the eastbound lane, then at Hunter Lake switching to the westbound lane. Finish line straight ahead!
