### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. The student must be enrolled in a Northern Nevada or Tahoe-Truckee area high school in 2019-2020 school year.
2. The student must be an active member of his or her high school cross country team and track team in that school year.
3. The student must attend college starting in the Fall of the 2020-2021 school year. Scholarship funds are to be applied to tuition or books.

The applicant's annual family income will be considered but will not be the determinative factor. The applicant's ability level will not be a factor, i.e. you do not have to be fast. The applicant is not required to run in college.

The deadline to apply is April 1, 2020. The applicant's information and essay response must be type written. The application must be postmarked by that date or hand delivered to the Race178 office by that date.

Race178 will make a decision by early May, 2020.
